Piszczor added to board; five returned to three-year terms

CHARLESTON — U.S. Bank's Tom Piszczor of New Salem, PA, was elected to the WVHI board of directors, replacing Rob Peterson of Kentucky, at the West Virginia Housing Institute Inc.'s annual statewide convention Wednesday in Charleston.

Piszczor, an at-large member, is a longtime industry official. He faced three other challengers during balloting at the WVHI convention. Each member company was allowed to cast one vote for the candidates. Piszczor was the overwhelming favorite.

At the same time, the statewide assembly at the Embassy Suites Hotel returned a slate of five other candidates to the 14-member board.

Re-elected to three-year terms were Vice President Karen Bailey and board members Tom Belasco II, Shane Masters, Marvin Stanley and Ralph Ball.
