### State regulatory board issues two licenses

CHARLESTON – The state board that licenses manufactured housing authorized two companies Wednesday to work in West Virginia.

A dealer license was approved for CMH Homes, Inc., of Hollis, VA, by the West Virginia Manufactured Housing Construction and Safety Standards Board.

The panel also issued a contractor license to Chapman Electric of Proctorville, OH.

The board approved payment of approximately \$2,000 from the recovery fund for work on damaged roofing shingles for a home purchased by Julie and Cletis Nicklow of Morgantown from Fleetwood Homes of Pennsylvania, Inc. The company has gone out of business.

The recovery fund, started and funded by the industry, pays for repairs to manufactured homes when damage is discovered and the manufacturer no longer is operational.
