State board acts on five licenses; delays one

CHARLESTON -- The state's manufactured housing licensing board approved license applications Wednesday from two Pennsylvania retail centers and three contractors, but delayed action on another company.

Retailer licenses were approved by the West Virginia Manufactured Housing Construction and Safety Standards Board for Rural Construction & Development, Inc., doing business as 422 Home Sales, locations at Indiana and at Belle Vernon, Pennsylvania.

The panel issued contractor licenses to Colebank's Construction, LLC, of Tunnelton, and K&L Construction, LLC, of Aurora. Both locations are in Preston County. Also granted a license was Stephen Moon doing business as Moon's Mobile Home Movers of Ceres, VA.

The State Board delayed a vote on a contractor application for Dunlap Mobile Home Services, LLC, of Peytona, Boone County.

The six-member State Board next meets on July 12 in Charleston.
